GUIDELINES FOR EXHIBITORS

Christmas Tree Festivals have become very popular in recent years and the organisers are encouraging all exhibitors to make their individual trees a real 'entertainment' for the public. Each tree should have a title and this should be reflected in the decorations. Trees may be decorated simply or elaborately, limited only by imagination. They may follow a colour scheme or a theme; they may tell a story; they may depict your organisation or group; they may do something else entirely different. The bigger the WOW factor, the better!

Each visitor will be given a voting slip as part of their entrance fee and prizes will be presented for the three most admired trees, determined by the public vote, at the 'Festival Finale Carol Sing-a-long' on Sunday 4th December at 4.00pm .

- Each exhibitor should provide their own tree, which may be real or artificial, together with a suitable stand.
- Setting-up times on Thursday 1st December shown on the Booking Form and all trees must be removed from the Church, following the Festival Finale Sing-a-long event, between 4.00pm - 6.00pm on Sunday, 4th December.
- Tree lights are welcome, but please do not use flashing or musical lights. The use of candles will not be allowed.
- Power sockets will be available. Please do NOT bring your own extension leads – suitably tested extension leads will be provided where possible and appropriate.
- The organisers reserve the right to remove any item they consider unsafe or inappropriate.
- There is no charge to enter a tree but you may wish to give a donation. Details can be found on the Booking Form.
